Clover steel silhouettes – 2/shooter

3x5 'pop can' steel silhouettes – 2/shooter

Approximately at noon there will be ½ hour lunch break (lunch provided by Boy Scouts) and change over to Carbine.

Note: Muskets may be used during the carbine events, for those who want to practice for the upcoming N-SSA Nationals.

4x4 ‘tile’ steel silhouettes – 2/shooter
