Event schedule (targeting subject to change)

8:00 AM Registration for musket and carbine begins

8:45 AM Registration ends

9:15 AM Commander's Meeting at the base of the tower for musket and carbine (attendance mandatory for all team commanders or their designate)

9:30 AM Opening Ceremonies

9:45 AM Musket competition begins

1. 24 clay pigeons on a backer
2. 12 3 x 5 metal tiles
3. 12 metal clovers
4. 12 metal stars
5. 12 whirly birds* + 1 hanging pigeon (rolling thunder begin on pigeon after shooter position number is called)

***SPECIAL BLUE/GRAY BRIGADE EVENT immediately following musket competition**

Approximately 12:30 ½ hour lunch break

1:00 PM Carbine Competition

1. 8 hanging pigeons
2. 8 metal stars
3. 8 3 x 5 metal tiles
4. 16 clay pigeons on a backer

Awards ceremony immediately following cleanup. All units are responsible for cleaning up their frames and ready areas. The Second Texas thanks you for your support and hopes you will have enjoyed a day of skirmishing.
